2. Confirmed students need to apply at <http://admission.ujs.edu.cn> (Online Application System for International Students).

After successful login, please choose the option “Non-degree Student”, then “General Visiting student” for BA programs, and “Senior Visiting Student” for MA & PhD programs.

For students who only wants to study Chinese please choose “Theme Chinese” of the Department “Language and Culture Centre”.

3. After submitting the online-application a PDF document will be generated, which needs to be signed by the student. Students need to send **the signed PDF, the Exchange Student Course Registration Form** to *Ms. Dai* via Email before the Application deadline.

VI. Language Requirements

Suggested language requirements for English taught programs: TOFEL above 75 or IELTS above 5.5 (or equivalent proficiency). All incoming exchange students have to be able to follow lectures and administrative procedures in English. Students majoring in Chinese at their home university and want to take regular classes of the program “Chinese Language and Literature” with native speakers at JSU, need to have HSK 5 or above.

VII. Accommodation

Type 1 (For Long-term Students): CNY 4,900/4,500/4,300/bed per academic year (10-12 months) for a double room, and the fee should be fully paid within 3 days after arrival.
