Agreement for Academic Cooperation between Institute of National Public Policy and Center for Science, Technology, and Innovation Policy

The Institute of National Public Policy at Chungnam National University (CNU) and the Center for Science, Technology, and Innovation Policy at the Schar School of Policy and Government at George Mason University (GMU) hereby mutually agree to develop an academic, educational, and cultural exchange agreement as follows:

- I. Both parties agree to develop a relationship including, but not limited to:
- 1. The reciprocal exchange of faculty, staff, and students
- 2. Joint research projects
- 3. Exchange of academic publications and information
- 4. Other academic activities.
- II. The parties recognize that further details regarding each of the activities listed above will be required prior to implementation of this agreement.
- III. The agreement signed by the two parties will remain valid for five (5) years. The agreement can change if both parties desire, but at least six (6) months notice must be given before the expiry date. At the end of the five-year term, the agreement will be extended automatically for a further five (5) years if no official request otherwise is taken into account.
- IV. The agreement can be amended or terminated as agreed by both universities.
- V. Two (2) copies of the agreement will be signed in English, and both copies are recognized as formal documents.
